New Solicitation: Addressing the Opioid Epidemic

The Comprehensive Addiction and Recovery Act (CARA) was signed into law on July 22, 2016 to establish a comprehensive, coordinated, and balanced strategy to address the opioid epidemic. The Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) has been allocated funding under CARA and has released two fiscal year (FY) 2017 solicitations: the [Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Site-based Program](#) and the [Comprehensive Opioid Abuse Program \(COAP\) Training and Technical Assistance \(TTA\) Program](#).
