- 1) The message about which group(s) will screen each day should be on the call-in line no later than 6:00a.m. To reduce the risk that you might miss a screen, you should call as near to 6:00a.m. as possible to learn if you are to give a screen that day. The number to call is 765-683-2006.
- 2) **Listen to the entire message** and follow instructions. Screens are done at 109 East 9th Street, Anderson, Indiana.
- 3) Take this sheet with you to the drop site. It will be signed by the person who monitors your screen. It is important to obtain a signature each time you screen. This is your confirmation that you did, in fact, screen.
- 4) Keep in mind that **a missed screen is a dirty screen**. This may result in a sanction. It could also impact your graduation if you cannot obtain six months consecutive clean time within the 36 months allowed in the Problem Solving Court Treatment Program.
